

2020 JAL Scholarship Program

The JAL Scholarship Program invites college students from across Asia and Oceania to Japan every year and provides them with opportunities for workshops and cultural interchange. Through these activities, the Program aims to enhance their understanding beyond national borders. This year, the Program will sponsor students to join a 22-day program in Japan tentatively from 22 June 2020 to 13 July 2020.

Scholarship Value	<p>The following expenses shall be paid by the sponsor and supporting organizations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Economy class airfare on Japan Airlines between Tokyo and the airport nearest to the student's residence served by JAL • All transportation in Japan during the official program, including domestic air/rail travel to cities outside Tokyo • All accommodation and meals • Travellers' accident insurance
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be aged 20 to 25 years old when the program commences. • Be a citizen of the country/region which he or she is applying for the program from and must be either an undergraduate or postgraduate student in that country/region. • Have a command of Japanese equivalent to, or above Japanese Proficiency Test Level 2 (All the lectures and discussions will be prepared and conducted in Japanese.) • Attend all classes, all sessions, and all activities scheduled by the organizer. • Have an interest in Japan and be willing to experience Japanese culture and customs. • Be healthy, of a cheerful disposition, and able to get along well with others.

Details	<p>One local student will be selected to represent Hong Kong to join the Program in Japan. Person who has not been to Japan would be chosen on a priority basis in order to promote the expansion of people regarded as friendly toward Japan.</p> <p>Interested students shall submit the completed type-written application form together with an essay in Japanese to tiffany.w@cityu.edu.hk by 11 March 2020 (Wednesday). Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend the JAL interview in the mid-March to end of March 2020.
